

4 Weeks In The Gospel of Mark

For life with Jesus there's nothing more foundational and simple than reading The Bible. What could be better than zooming in on the life of The Bible's main character, our Lord Jesus Christ. Mark's Gospel moves fast through Jesus' miracles, teaching, conflicts, His death, and ultimately His resurrection.

This plan is set up to be used with The Message by Eugene Petersen which is in contemporary language that brings a freshness to the story for those who are familiar with the text and an accessibility for those who are new to The Bible.
